We return to worship this Sunday June 14th and it will certainly be different than your last pre-COVID19 experience at Grace. **Please pay close attention to this communication.**

- Holy Eucharist services will hopefully begin in July.
- If you are sick or considered vulnerable, please remain at home and view our Virtual worship service.
- All attendees must supply contact information before entering the church.

- Please bring your mask with you to the service.
- If you do not have one, we will provide one for you. Masks are required while anywhere on campus and during the entire service.
- Attendees must comply with social distance measures and other safety protocols as we prescribe.
- Childcare will not be provided at this time.
- Families are welcome to bring their children to the service.
- Bathrooms will be opened but Jackson Hall will be closed.
- Congregational singing will NOT be permitted.
- There will be no printed bulletins, if you would like a bulletin please print one and bring it with you or you may use the Book of Common Prayer. The bulletin can be found on <https://www.gracechurchwfp.org/covid-19-pandemic.html>.
- We have developed a plan to ensure that appropriate distances between family groups will be observed at all times. You will be directed by an usher to sit in a particular pew based on the plan. We are not able to accommodate or allow you to sit in your favorite pew.
- At the end of the service, you will be directed as to how to exit the church.
- In the unfortunate circumstance that you are diagnosed with the COVID19 virus, please notify us that this has occurred.

Historic Tax Credits available for purchase

Grace Church applied for and received \$91,883.00 worth of Historic Tax Credits from the State Office of Historic Preservation for the renovation of Jackson Hall. We are able to sell the tax credits to help individuals and companies offset their Louisiana income tax owed. We are happy to announce that we have sold a portion of our credits, the proceeds from the sale help offset the costs of the renovation of Jackson Hall. However, we do still have **\$23,912.00** worth of tax credits available for purchase.
