## Invite, Welcome, Connect

On Saturday, November 16, from 9 AM to 3 PM, the Baton Rouge Deanery of the Episcopal Diocese of Louisiana will proudly present a great seminar called, Invite-Welcome-Connect at St. Lukes Episcopal Church, 8833 Goodwood Blvd Baton Rouge, LA. The registration fee of \$20 includes lunch and is open to all Episcopalians from around the Diocese. I hope you can join us. Call our office if you would like to carpool. Now, let me give you some information about why I believe this is a great program.

Fr. Tommy Dillon, from St. Margaret's, describes Invite-Welcome-Connect the following way: "This is a transformational ministry that equips and empowers clergy and lay leaders to cultivate intentional practices of evangelism, hospitality, and belonging rooted in the Gospel imperative to 'Go and make disciples of all nations' (Matthew 28:19). It is a ministry of relational evangelism and congregational empowerment allowing churches to become places of genuine connection."

This program invites all of us to welcome and honor the faith journeys and stories of everyone. The goal is to "enable deeper journeys of Christian discipleship, allowing the Spirit of Christ to be at the heart of our hospitality." Invite-Welcome-Connect has become a proven hospitality and evangelism program within the Episcopal Church. Over fifty dioceses, several Episcopal seminaries, and three universities have implemented the program in the last five years with remarkable success, reporting measurable results after using the materials.

We have invited Mary Palmer, a Certified Facilitator, to be our instructor for this event. "Mary has worked with leaders and clergy in numerous capacities for over 25 years to support God's mission for the Church. She was crucial to the establishment of the Iona School for Ministry in Texas, which has formally trained and graduated over 65 priests and deacons so far. Mary has a particular passion for evangelism, stewardship, and lay and clergy development. She has been invited to be the keynote speaker, consultant, and trainer of 35 dioceses of the Episcopal Church.

Mary serves on the Steering Committee of the Gathering of Leaders, doing specialized work with the Episcopal Church Foundation. She is also a board member of the College for Bishops. A graduate of Louisiana State University, Mary looks forward to being back in Baton Rouge."

The Rev'd John A. Kellogg, Diocesan Canon Missioner describes the program the following way: "One of the great joys of my job is traveling around the Diocese, meeting with congregations of all shapes and sizes. Although these churches possess unique gifts and face distinct challenges, I hear the same comment over and over: our

congregation wants to grow. During the Invite-Welcome-Connect workshop, Mary explores how churches can implement practices and strategies that lead to growth. Mary's presentations are practical, thorough, and thought-provoking. Her teaching style is relevant and compelling. Perhaps most importantly, Mary's guidance has the potential to transform your congregation. I highly recommend attending an Invite-Welcome-Connect workshop. You will leave feeling inspired and prepared to lead your congregation with renewed energy. Our congregations must learn how to invite effectively, welcome, and connect newcomers into our communities."

Now, I know what some of you may be thinking, "The job of growing the church belongs to the Rector and his staff." This is both correct and incorrect. Yes, the rector must ensure that all visitors are welcome, the Gospel is preached authentically and passionately, and people feel accepted and appreciated when they come to Grace. But, the bulk of the responsibility to befriend, welcome, and connect visitors falls on the entire congregation. Research shows that most people visit a church because they were invited by a friend, are passing through, or have recently relocated to the area. The level of hospitality they receive from existing members on their first visit, however, determines whether they return, connect, and become involved.

Join us as we explore exciting ways to continue to grow our beloved Church. For the last few years, God has blessed us with new members, including many young families. There is more we can do, however, to attract and connect other spiritual seekers looking for a home. Our goal is to create an Invite-Welcome-Connect team of those who attend this training. This team will then become the nucleus of a new welcoming ministry for Grace Church in 2020. I pray you will choose to join us.
